

Glossary of Herbicides to accompany the leaflet:

BRACKEN, GORSE AND RUSH CONTROL Tried and Tested Methods used by Farmer Network Members.

Asulam i.e. Asulox is a selective herbicide for the control of Bracken absorbed by the leaves shoots and root of the plant.

Grazon contains 'Picloram' herbicide. It is absorbed through foliage, stem or roots and transported through the plant so prevents growth.

Glyphosate i.e. Clinic Ace or Round-Up. It is non-selective so kills most plants. It prevents plants making certain proteins so prevents growth.

MCPA i.e. Larke. It stimulates plant hormones causing uncoordinated growth that disrupts new seedlings and existing plants.

Wetter is used in conjunction with MCPA. It reduces drift and evaporation and improves plant uptake and speed of kill.
