

YORKSHIRE DALES TRAINING VOUCHER SCHEME

The Farmer Network's Yorkshire Dales
Training Voucher Scheme is funded by the
Farming in Protected Landscapes Programme.
It is designed to help farmers afford the cost
of training and certificates of competence
related to operating their farm business.

This scheme is open to all farmers based in the Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority, including their employees and family.

Training must be booked before the application is made and vouchers are reimbursed once the training has been completed. **Vouchers worth up to £200** can be used for a wide range of training courses including:

- countryside management chainsaw use, hedge laying and walling
- animal husbandry courses sheep shearing/calfrearing/foot trimming/Al
- safe use of machinery such as ATVs/tractors/ telehandlers
- safe use of pesticides and aluminium phosphide
- rodent control
- use of farm business software packages
